Introducing the CC TAP Grant

The California Community College Chancellor's Office (CCCCO) awarded NOCE a \$1.8 million grant as the Community College Technical Assistance Provider (CC TAP) to enhance the technical assistance capacity currently provided for noncredit community colleges and the California Adult Education Program (CAEP) consortia.

CC TAP will support and promote CAEP efforts to:

- Increase student outcomes for CAEP noncredit students
- Support career mobility for adult learners
- Provide equitable training and technical assistance services for the CAEP community.

To bridge the gap between available digital tools, requirements on reporting, and current knowledge to provide general information to community colleges interested in starting a noncredit adult education program.

2023 Adult Education Needs Assessment Survey Results



Adult Education Needs Survey Results Spring 2023


214 Responses received:

- 116 CCDs (54%)
- 81 K-12 Adult Schools (38%)
- 9 COEs (4%)
- 8 others (4%)

Professional Development Topic Preferences	
Area of Interest	Response Count, %
Data & Accountability	68, 59%
Program Improvement & Evaluation	59, 51%
Leveraging & Braiding Funding	57, 49%

2023 Adult Education Needs Survey Findings

- Majority of CC/CCD respondents in roles <6yrs (n=82, 71%)
- Over half of these in role <3 yrs (n=49, 60%)
- 47 stated have <u>never</u> attended CAEP TAP event (41%); 33 (70%) of these are administrators
- Preference for virtual over inperson PD except for conferences



2023 Adult Education Needs Survey Findings

Most survey respondents – both CC/CCD and K-12 – felt the CAEP website is busy, that it is hard to find what they are seeking, and that the site is difficult to navigate. **This supports a potential project to update the CAEP website** (www.caladulted.org).

Website Comment Sampling:

"I am on...frequently, but it doesn't seem to have clear information or access to clear information for community college leaders on program design and implementation or data reporting."

"I consult [the site] frequently. Currently...titles of the materials do not match my search. For example, I currently need to use the "News" tab to look up "due dates" Due dates should be it's own tab"

"I consult the CAEP website when I am looking for webinars and events. I always get confused between AEP Events and Webinars. I suggest merging the two categories to make it easy to find events/webinars as the line between the two is blurred."

"I enjoy the resources on the site and tend to be able to access what I need when I need it."



2023 Adult Education Needs Survey Findings cont.

Those who have attended a CAEP event preferred the following topics:

- Understanding changes in CAEP policy (48, 41%)
- Understanding CAEP at a technical level (44, 38%)
- Networking (27, 23%)

In existing PD, areas of low knowledge confidence (i.e. opportunities to improve) are:

- COMIS Reporting
- TOPSpro Enterprise (TE) Reporting. Low demand: just over half of CC/CCD respondents don't use, or know of, TE.
- Adult Education Pipeline LaunchBoard (WestEd)
