Did you know...

Did you know that your 19-20 COLA allocation could be determined by your consortium bylaws? Please see some facts about determining your member allocation as part of the CFAD process due May 2, 2019.

- 1. Existing consortium members are guaranteed the same \$\$ amount as they received last year on the CFAD.
- 2. By-laws will govern the decision making for the amount above the prior year amount.
  - (Note if you have no by-laws on CFAD decision making and fail to reach an agreement, see #3).
- 3. If you fail to submit your CFAD by May 2nd the State will use the prior year percentage/proportional spilt for all the 19-20 funding.
- 4. If the by-laws are followed and a decision is made and a member fails to certify the CFAD in NOVA the consortium can contact the State to input the allocation information into NOVA (and meet the May 2<sup>nd</sup> deadline).
- 5. If the members voluntarily agree to reduce their allocation, and the members are agreeable to that then you can reduce their allocation below the prior year without cause ("cause" means the 3 reasons for reducing funds in education code (84914) for CAEP).
