
Measurable Skills Gains (MSG) - YOUTH

- 1. Document Literacy/Numeracy Pre-Test (Below 9th grade level); and
- 2. Document Literacy/Numeracy Post-Test

- 1. Is attending or enrolls in secondary or post-secondary education; and
- Submits a transcript/report card that meets the State unit's academic standards. (Full time - 12 hours per semester, Part time 12 hours over two semesters)

Training Milestone

- 1. During the program, enrolls in an ITA or Registered Apprenticeship; and
- 2. Submits a satisfactory or better progress report towards established milestone from employer or training provider.

Skills Progression

1. Is enrolled in an education or activity training code.

POSITIVE

- a. Completes an exam required for a particular occupation; OR
- b. Submits documented progress in attaining technical or occupational skills
