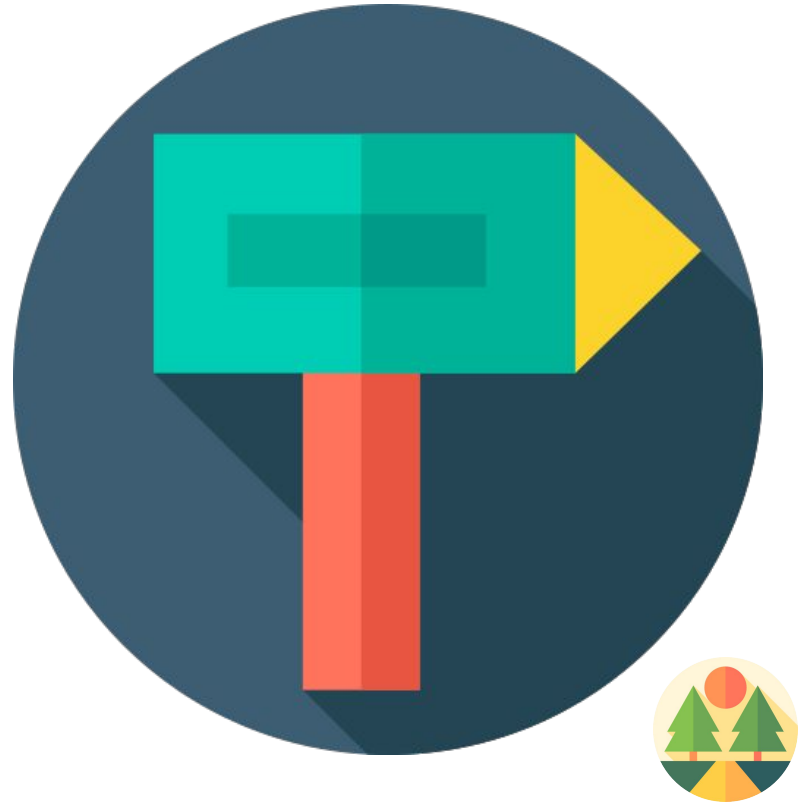
GP Mindsets: Helping Students Enter the Path
