


AEP 4.0 & 4.1 Release Announcement

April 26, 2021 Adult Education Pipeline (AEP) dashboard was updated and launched with the 2019-2020 data (data sources: COMIS and CASAS TOPSpro Enterprise).

The new release also includes new features:

- Top 5 Comparison of Institutions that help you easily explore the institutions that are reporting the highest levels of outcomes in the state or within the region. This feature can offer insights and identify networks for exploring programming and planning issues.
- Drill Downs that help you explore data with more nuance.
- Refined calculations to better report K-12 Adult Education Schools and Non-Credit Community College populations and outcomes. For a full list of changes see the [“Changes in Definitions”](#) document located under the “Find out more...” section at the bottom of the dashboard site.
- New icon  that can be clicked to access more detailed information to dashboard users.

May 31, 2021 AEP Dashboard additional updates: On this date the AEP Dashboard will be refreshed to account for:

- Update to the calculation to correct for the inclusion of students with disabilities who were also credit community college students. (Community colleges may notice a drop in Reportable Individual/Adults Served numbers as it corrects for this refined calculation.)
- Update to the barrier to employment metric, Exhausting TANF in Two Years; counts have been adjusted in this release.
- Added three new charts:
 - Time to Completion of Transfer-Level English (found on the Progress Detailed Data page)
 - Time to Completion of Transfer-Level Math (found on the Progress Detailed Data page)
 - Top 5 Institutions for Employment 2 Quarters After Exit (found on the Employment and Earnings Detailed Data page)
