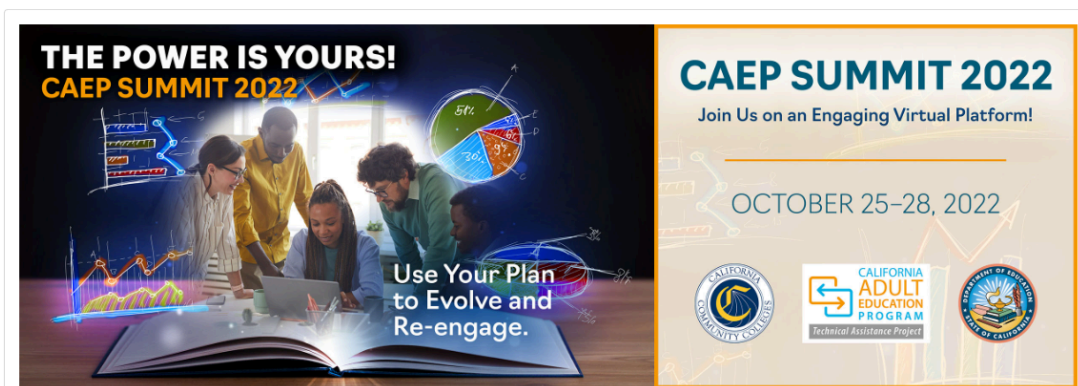

## Opening

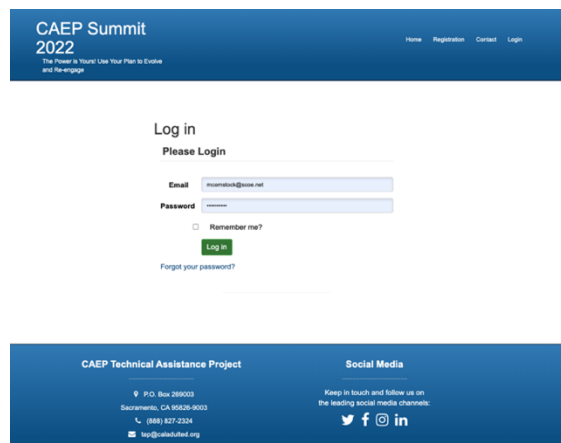
The CAEP Summit 2022 virtual conference platform was designed to deliver high quality, interactive sessions, and networking opportunities. This user guide provides guidance on how to navigate the virtual conference platform, including logging in, creating a schedule, accessing sessions and resources, and networking. ## Login

Login using your email and password you registered with.

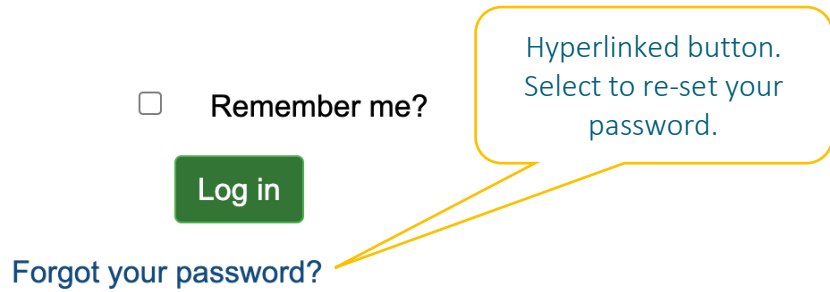


Navigate to the Login button in the menu bar on the Summit 2022 website. Once you hit the login button, a new window will appear. It will have a space for you to enter your email and password. The password will be the same one used to register.



## Forgot Password

If you forgot your password, select the hyperlinked 'Forgot your password?' button located under the email and password criteria box. You will be directed to another page where you can enter your email and a new link will be sent to re-set your password.



You will be sent to another page to enter the email address you registered with, and a re-set password link will be sent.

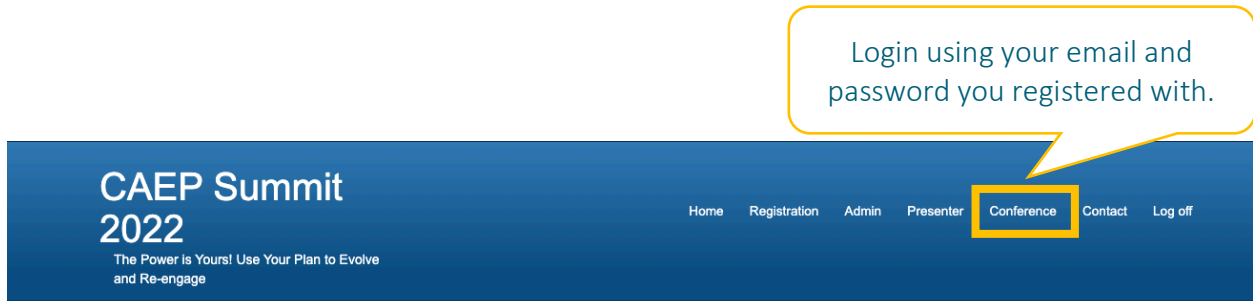

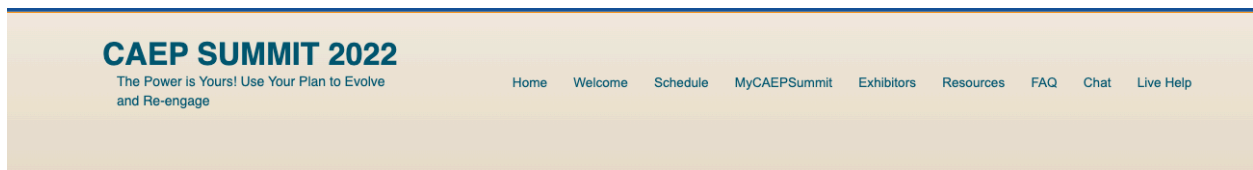

### Conference

The 'Conference' tab will appear in the top menu bar. Select the Conference button to enter the landing page of the CAEP Summit 2022 platform.

The CAEP Summit 2022 landing page provides information related to the following:

### Access the Virtual Platform

No attendees will be able to join sessions without first logging into the site. The virtual platform opens for all attendees at **9:30 a.m. on Tuesday, October 25, 2022.**

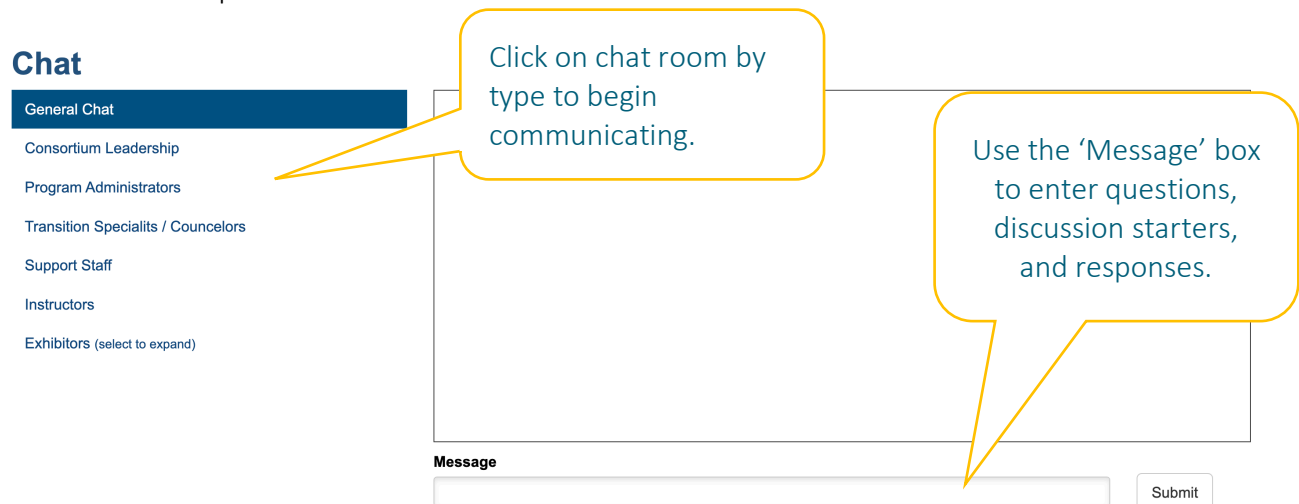
## Chat

The section provides an opportunity for all attendees to chat with one another related to general topics, their roles in adult education, and with specific exhibitors. The virtual conference platform does not offer a private chat feature. The virtual conference platform also does not list attendees who are attending the conference and if they are logged on to the platform at any given time.

In the general chat room, attendees can ask questions and converse about general conference topics such as when does the jam sessions are scheduled, how to access presenters' handouts, when will the session recordings will be available, and more.

Attendees can use the 'Roles' chat rooms to ask questions and have specific discussions related to particular roles. For example, consortium leads can use their designated chat room to ask questions and have discussions related to organizing and hosting consortium-wide professional development days. Transition specialists can share the strategies they are using to support adult learners in reaching their educational goals.

To use the chat, click on the specific chat room, then begin typing your message in the 'Message' field. After clicking on 'Submit', your message will appear in the field. When attendees reply, you will see their response in the chat box.
