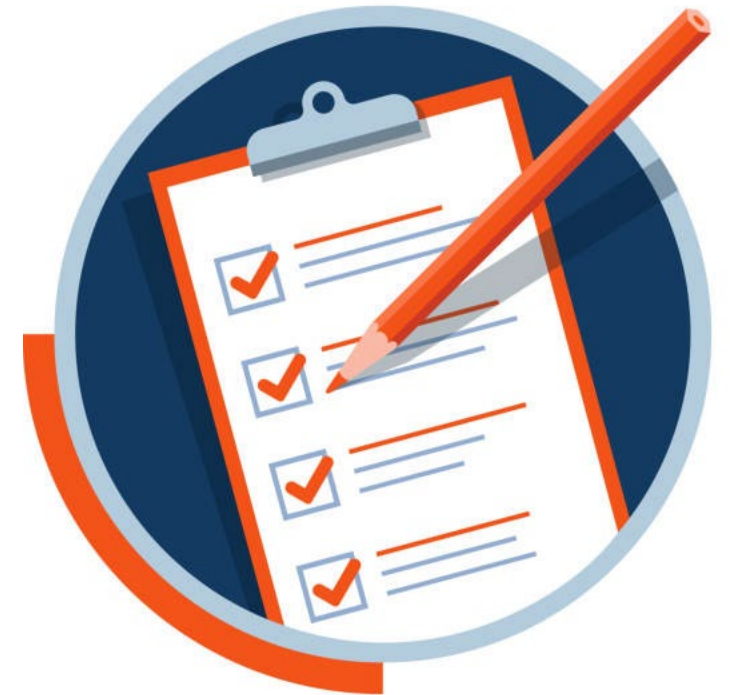

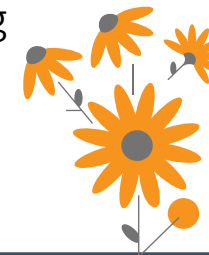

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Personalized Feedback

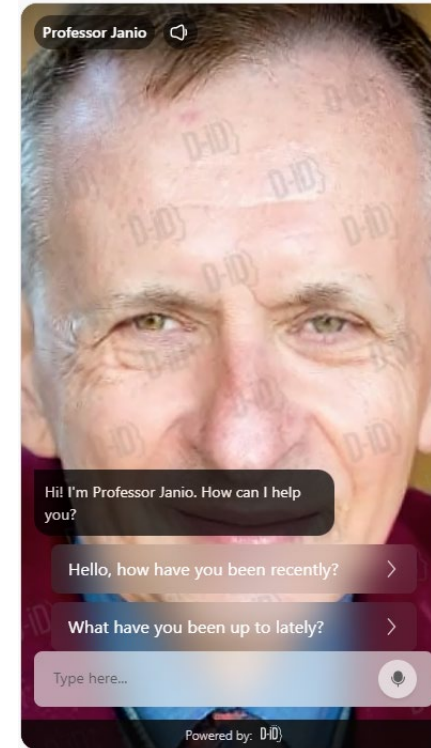
- AI-powered tools adapt to individual skill levels and learning needs.

- AI: Enhancing, not replacing human expertise
- Empowering self-service for simple queries
- Reducing turnaround time for technical assistance.
- Majority of TA requests received concern allowable expenses and fiscal matters – AI speeds this process.

Pro: Advanced AI models, larger file uploads.

Free: Basic functionality with limited file uploads.

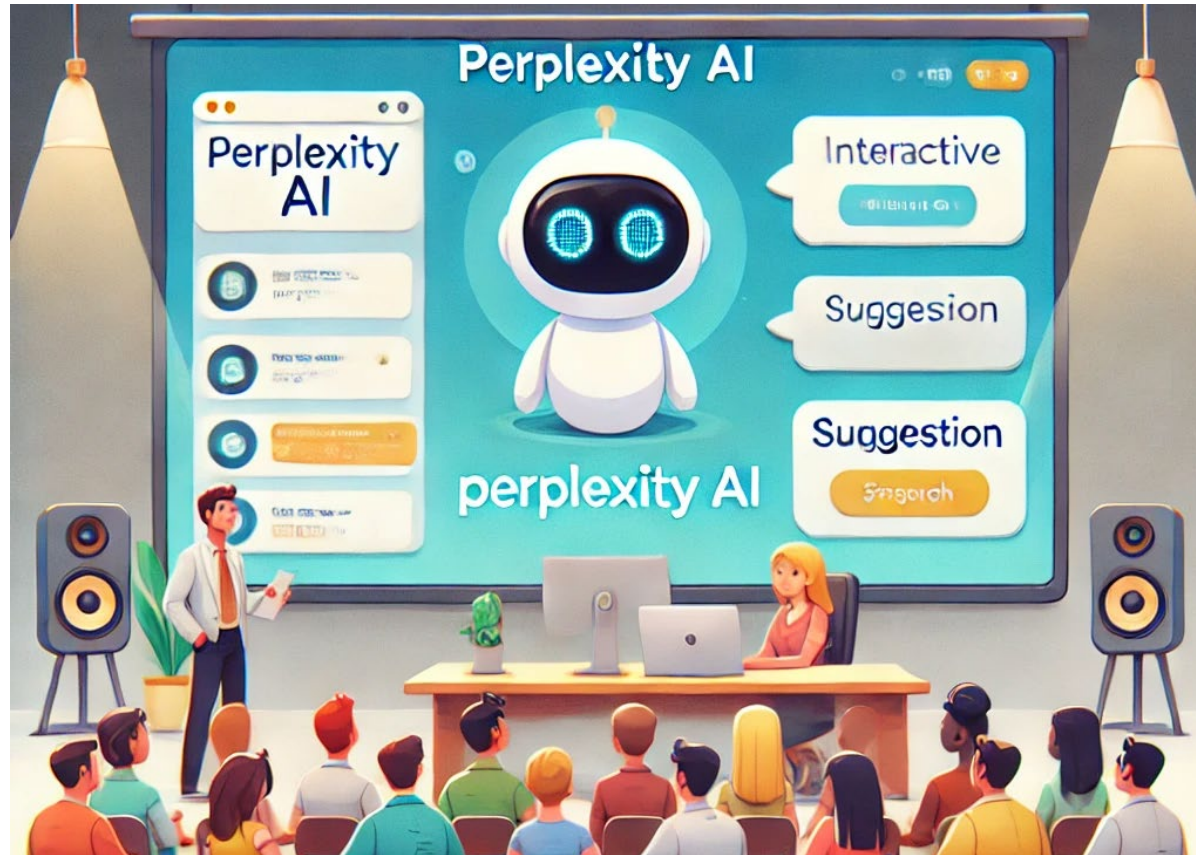
