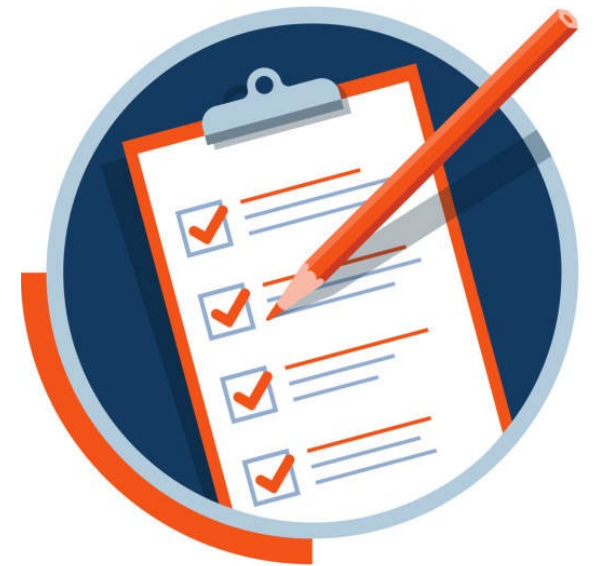

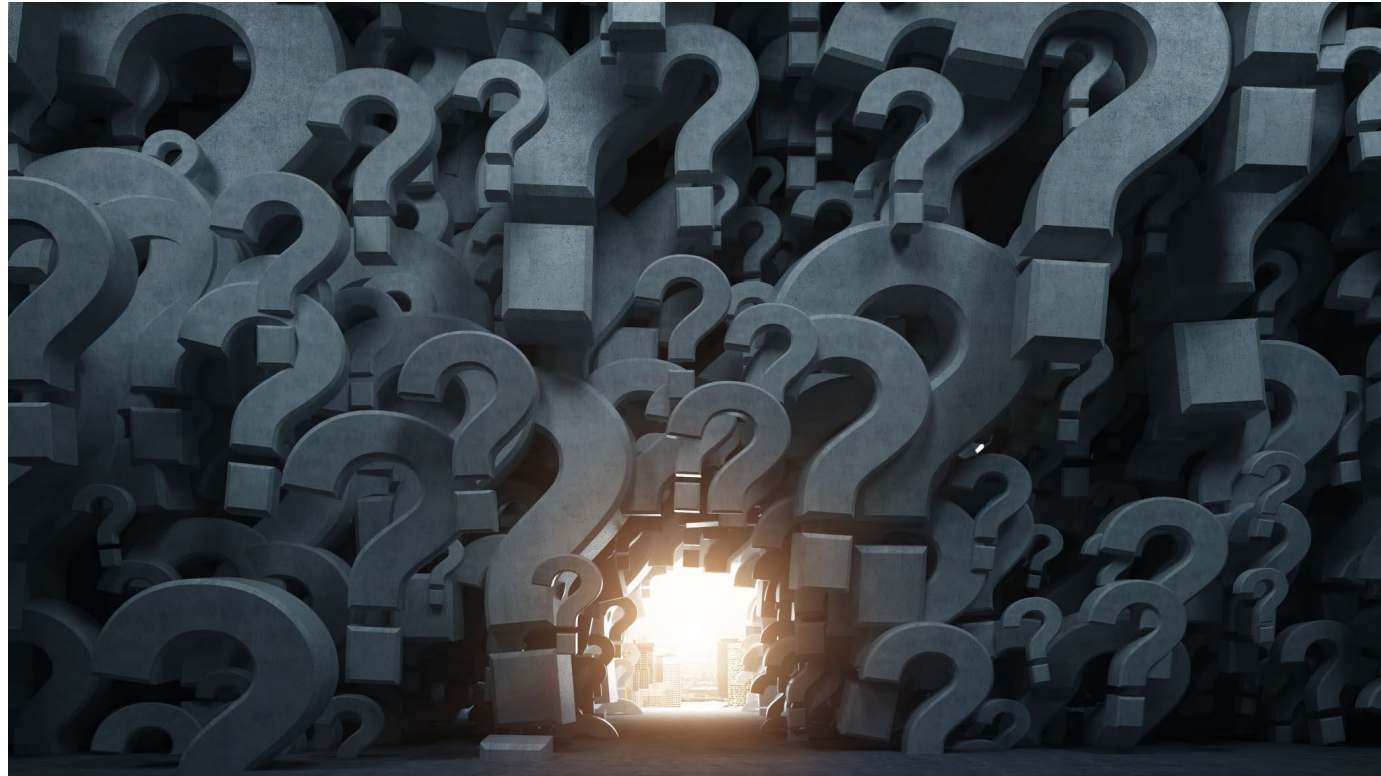

AI Technologies

Artificial Intelligence

Artificial intelligence (AI) makes it possible for machines to learn from experience, adjust to new inputs, and perform human-like tasks.

Machine Learning

Machine learning is a method of data analysis that automates analytical model building. It is a branch of artificial intelligence based on the idea that systems can learn from data, identify patterns and make decisions with minimal human intervention.

Deep learning

Deep learning is a type of machine learning that trains a computer to perform human-like tasks, such as recognizing speech, identifying images or making predictions.

Natural Language Processing

Natural language processing (NLP) is a branch of artificial intelligence that helps computers understand, interpret and manipulate human language.

Computer Vision

Computer vision is a field of artificial intelligence that trains computers to interpret and understand the visual world. Using digital images from cameras and videos and deep learning models, machines can accurately identify and classify objects and then react to what they “see.”

Brief Review from Previous AI Webinar

- AI: Enhancing, not replacing human expertise
- Empowering self-service for simple queries
- Reducing turnaround time for technical assistance.
- Majority of TA requests received concern allowable expenses and fiscal matters – AI speeds this process.

AI Platform Overview



ChatGPT

Premium: Faster response times, priority access to new features.
Free: Access to basic features, ideal for general inquiries and tasks.

ChatGPT streamlines technical assistance by referencing relevant resources, providing accurate, and efficient support, and saving time for both requesters and teams.

Upload Documents to ChatGPT

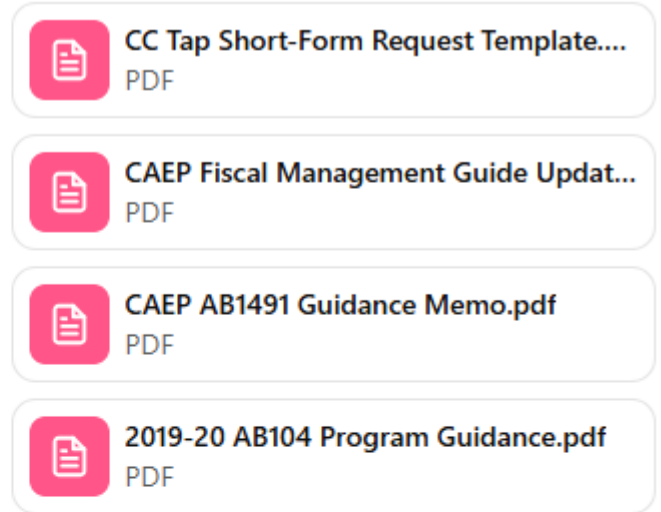
- **Upload CAEP and local resources directly into ChatGPT (or your preferred AI tool).**

By doing so, you ensure accurate and contextually relevant responses. Skipping this step may result in incomplete or inaccurate information.

- **Rename the chat for easier referencing in the future.**
We recommend naming it “*CAEP Files.*”

Example:

“Use these documents as a resource for the future queries I will send later. As of now, please do not summarize any of these documents, simply store their information.”

Please use these documents as a resource for the future queries I will send later. As of now, please do not summarize any of these documents, simply store their information.

Create a New Chat, and Reference Stored Memory

- **Be Specific:**
Use detailed prompts similar to the example shown to effectively frame your TA request.
- **Reference Relevant Resources:**
Clearly identify the chat or document containing the necessary resources to resolve the request.
- **Key Tip:**
The more specific and resource-oriented your prompt, the more accurate and actionable the response will be.

Example:

"Hi ChatGPT, please resolve the following TA request by referencing [specific resource/document name]..."

What can I help with?

Hi Chat GPT. Please resolve the following TA request by referencing our previous chat containing important resources, "CAEP Files." Remember to follow the Short Form Template while resolving this TA.

Review the Response for Accuracy

Ensure the response aligns with your expectations and addresses your inquiry comprehensively.

Regardless of the response, we strongly encourage the CAEP field to consult CAEP TAP to ensure the response aligns with your expectations and addresses your inquiry comprehensively:

- Confirmation of Validity
- Additional Guidance

Remember: CAEP TAP is here to support you. Do not hesitate to reach out for assistance.



Here is the resolved TA request based on the information provided and the resources stored:
