Why: By 2018, 63 percent of all U.S. jobs will require education beyond high school. Yet, in California, 18 percent of those aged 25 and older do not have a high school diploma or its equivalent. In 2016, the statewide annual average unemployment rate for this population was 8.2 percent. Immigrants comprise a disproportionately large percentage (36 percent) of this population. The poverty rate for California individuals without a high school diploma is 26 percent, which is 10.3 percent higher than those with a high school diploma and 15 percent higher than those with some college or an associate degree.
