AEBG Hot Topics

- Governor's Budget - \$500M – but.....
- 15/16 (Period 3) & 16/17 (Period 1) Expenditure & Progress Reports due by 1/31/17.
- Data and Accountability Plans & Budgets due by 2/20/17.
- Preliminary allocations for 17/18 out next month.
- CFAD to open soon.
- 15/16 AEBG funds must be ***spent by 12/31/17!!!***

AEBG Regional Training

Regional Training – Testing & Assessment

- Use of NRS approved assessment tools to track student progress
- Pre/Post Testing Guidelines
 - Implement testing for those with 12 hours or more of instruction
 - ABE, ASE & ESL
 - Not required for those with a HS diploma/GED or equivalent
 - Options for assessing AWD students
 - CTE & K-12 Parent Success – in process / not required at this time

Regional Training – Follow Up

- How to report follow-up per the AB104 legislation
 - Literacy skills gains
 - HS diploma/GED or equivalent
 - Completion of post secondary degrees, industry recognized certificates or training programs.
 - Transition into post secondary
 - Placement into jobs and increased wages
- Potential use of state level data (in process)
 - for employment & wages
 - post secondary student outcomes

- Basic navigation
 - Installing
 - File format
 - Creating & editing data
 - Scanning & importing data
- Using TE Reports
- Using TE with other Student Data Management Systems

Regional Training – Reporting Follow Up Data

- Review of Entry and Update forms
- Review of operational definitions and data dictionary
- Submission of performance data

Regional Training – Issues needing more review

- Collection of student employment & wage information
- Adding additional metrics
- Measuring skill gains / progress for CTE and K-12 Parent Success students
- Assessing progress of students in contextualized classes and upper level Basic Skills courses
- Use of Spanish language assessment tools
- List of approved industry recognized credentials
