<u>Regional gap</u>: tools for parents and educators for socio-emotional support of children

<u>Solution</u>: Love and Logic courses for parents and training for teachers

<u>Outcome</u>: classroom and school environment that stimulate responsible behavior and high levels of academic achievement





LOVE AND LOGIC

Love and Logic Tools

- Preventing misbehavior and increasing instructional time on task
- Avoiding power struggle while setting limits
- Teaching character and responsibility through the application of logical consequences instead of punishment
- Developing positive cooperative relationships

- Eight L&L Workshops
- Number of participants: 225
- Partner Districts: Centralia Elementary, Fullerton Joint Union High, North Orange County Community College, La Habra, Placentia Yorba Linda Unified

Outcomes:

- Instructional center uniquely equipped to provide academic and emotional support for students with ASD
- Professional development for K12 staff and faculty: "Survival Kit", Autism Ally, Transition Planning
- Work placement outreach for students on ASD

• Pilot ARISE elements at other NOCRC sites and develop instructional modules on workplace prep skills for students on ASD
